CODE OF CONDUCT/Liability Waiver

In consideration of the acceptance of the Participant named herein below ("Player") to travel to a Basketball Tournament. Player and the Parent(s) or Legal Guardian(s) of Player must agree to and sign the following Code of Conduct:

- Players are expected to be on their best behavior during the entire tournament. This includes being respectful of each other, The Texas Tigers staff, the individuals at respective venues and hotel staff, and any other individuals met during the tournament.
- Players are expected to act in a responsible manner at all times, use good judgment, and comply with group rules and standards.
- Players must stay with the Texas Tigers group at all times and are not permitted to make arrangements to meet other individuals throughout the duration of the tournament including any family members.
- Players are responsible for the handling of their own monies. Texas Tigers Basketball will not give financial assistance to Players. Players should have an ATM card and/or credit card for their use during the tournament.
- Players shall refrain from the use of alcohol and/or any illegal substances. Any use of these substances will result in the automatic suspension of the Player from the tournament. The parent or legal guardian will be required to pick up their son or daughter immediately or pay for the expense of returning the player to their parents immediately.
- In the event a Player is found with any illegal substance, Texas Tigers will notify the local police in the city in which we will be visiting. In the event there is an arrest, the Player will remain in the custody of the police and Texas Tigers Basketball will be released of all liability and responsibility for such Player.
- Any damages caused by the Player to the charter bus, or any other transportation, used by Texas Tigers Basketball, will be paid for by the Player's parent or legal guardians.
- In the event the tournament includes an overnight stay at a hotel, Players will not be issued a room key. Player agrees to not use the mini bar, room service or cause any other room charges. Bed checks will take place nightly by the chaperones, and Players will be expected to stay in their assigned rooms once bed check has taken place. Players are not allowed in rooms of individuals of the opposite sex for any reason (unless accompanied by staff). Players are not allowed to switch roommates once assigned. Any damages or theft caused by the Player in the hotel will be paid for by the Player's parents, or legal guardians.

We have read and understand the foregoing Code of Conduct. We have discussed the behavioral standards and agree that the Player shall abide by the rules of Texas Tigers Basketball, and that any violation will result in the Player being sent home at the Parent's or Legal Guardian's expense.

Texas Tigers Basketball reserves the right to refuse registration to any person or any player, or to expel any person whose actions disrupts or impedes the operation of the program or the welfare and enjoyment of the other members of the program. No refund will be made to any participant who is rejected by the Texas Tigers Basketball Organization for any such reason, nor can any refund be made to any participant who is unable to complete the tournament, or any portion of the tournament for any reason.

RELEASE

The Parent voluntarily releases, discharges, waives and relinquishes all claims or actions that the Parent may have against Texas Tigers Basketball, its officers, agents and employees, for bodily injury, emotional distress, property damage, and/or wrongful death, occurring to the Player arising out of or in any way connected to the Player's participation in the Basketball tournament with Texas Tigers Basketball, including, but not limited to, those claims or actions arising out of any negligence on the part of Texas Tigers Basketball, its officers, agents and employees, save and except only those claims due to fraud or willful injury to the Player, or violation of law. **It is the intent of this agreement to exempt and relieve Texas Tigers Basketball, its officers, agents and employees, from liability for personal injury, emotional distress, property damage or wrongful death caused by negligence.**

THE PARENT UNDERSTANDS THAT IF THE PARENT IS NOT COMFORTABLE WITH THE STATEMENTS MADE ABOVE, THE PARENT SHOULD NOT SEND THE PLAYER ON THIS TRIP. BY THE PARENT'S SIGNATURE HEREON, THE PARENT AFFIRMS UNDERSTANDING OF AND AGREEMENT TO THE FOREGOING. THE PARENT HAS REVIEWED THIS DOCUMENT WITH THE PLAYER, WHOSE SIGNATURE INDICATES ACCEPTANCE OF THE RISKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THIS TRIP AND CONSTITUTES A PLEDGE TO OBEY ALL TRIP RULES.
